

## **Proposed Amendment to Chapter 2: Definitions**

### **Current Definition**

Monument Sign is a ground sign generally having a low profile with little or no open space between the ground and the sign and having a structure constructed of masonry, wood, or materials similar in appearance as approved by the building official.

### **Revised Definition**

Monument Sign: A free-standing sign, generally having a low profile where the base of the sign structure is on the ground or a maximum of twelve inches (12") above the lowest point of the ground adjacent to the sign such that the sign has the appearance of a solid base. The maximum height shall be eight feet (8') from the ground, the maximum length shall be fourteen feet (14'), and the maximum thickness shall be three feet (3') unless otherwise stated in Chapter 16 or in an Urban Design Overlay District. The maximum sign face area shall cover no more than 60% of the sign.
